There are many ways you can support this at home such as:

- Go on a walk and see how many cars you can see.
- Talk to your child about the different types of vehicles you see whilst you are out and about.
- Go on a journey on a train or bus. We would love to hear all about it at nursery.
- Look at and talk about the different features on different vehicles.
- Explore different ways in which you can move. For example running, walking, sliding.
- Look at the letters and numbers you can see on the registration plates.
- Draw/write about what vehicles you see

Please ensure that your child brings a bag to nursery with spare clothes, there are times when children need to be changed due to a variety of reasons. For example slipping in the mud, spilling a drink down them, having an accident.

Can you also ensure that your child's coats, jackets and shoes are labelled clearly with their full name, this will help us ensure things don't get misplaced. Thank you
