



Wednesday workout!

We continue to focus on children's Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED) and helping children to play alongside each other and form friendships.

We are now beginning to bring other areas of learning into focus. The children continue to explore the great outdoors in all weathers. They continue to be fascinated by mini-beasts. They are beginning to notice leaves that are changing colour and falling from the trees.

It is incredibly important children are aware of the environment and can use language to talk about what they see, hear, smell and feel. We are promoting children's natural curiosity of the seasons and are exploring the differences in the leaves we find; Looking at shape, size and colour.

There are many ways you can support this at home such as:

- Go on an Autumn walk and talk to your child about everything you can see.
- Collect items on your Autumn walk and use these to create a natural art picture. Talking with children about how they have arranged the objects they have chosen.
- Take photos of your walk and when you go again look at the photos and talk about what has changed/stayed the same.
- Talk about the changes as you walk to and from nursery, even if it's just from the car park, you will be amazed at what changes.



Add your autumn walk to Tapestry, sharing photos and videos of your adventures. If you are struggling accessing Tapestry then please speak to Natalie.
