- Talk to your children about the weather and the changes in their environment and get them to describe what they can see
- Encourage your children to put on their own coat and do their own zip, don't forget to tell your child's key worker or pop it on tapestry if they can do it
- Create a winter picture using blue and white resources and bring it to nursery to show everyone







As the weather is getting colder, please ensure that children attend nursery with appropriate clothing suited to the weather. It is also very muddy outside, please send them in footwear you don't mind getting dirty.
