### **Additional Information**

- If your child is eligible for 15 free hours, this will not be included in your fees.
- Prices will change for the half term after your child turns 3.
- If your child is eligible for 30 free hours, there will be a charge as follows depending on how you utilise your 30 hours:
  - Over 5 days (packed lunch) – weekly charge of £15.00 that includes snacks and additional 2.5 hours care
  - Over 3 days (packed lunch) – weekly charge of £9.00 that includes breakfast, snacks and light tea.
- The 15 free hours of nursery education **only** apply to the teacher led sessions in term time (09:00 – 12:00 and 12:30 – 15:30). Free hours are not available during school holidays.
- Breakfast and after school sessions include a snack/light tea
- The fees above are subject to a minimum of 2 sessions per week
- Fees are payable weekly
- We will **not** charge for bank holidays or Inset days when the Centre is closed
- No session fees are payable during the Christmas period when the Nursery School is closed
- **Booked sessions which are not attended will still be charged**
- Bookings for each half term must be finalised before the start of the term. Bookings made stand for the full period of the half term. Any changes to sessions will only be permitted in special circumstances with the agreement of the Headteacher.
